## **WET'N'WILD CONCERT BAND EXCURSION PERMISSION NOTE**

Concert Band students who have shown sustained commitment to our band are invited to Wet'n'Wild on Tuesday 17 December 2024. All rides and pools are included in the cost of entry.

**Advice from Wet'n'Wild:** Students and parents who hold a current Annual pass are required to bring the pass on the day to secure entry without paying. If students are unable to provide the Annual Pass in physical form on the day, please send a scanned/photocopy to the school office with this permission note and we will take these copies with us on the day for scanning. Please note, this scanned/photocopy must be clear and legible (as they will need to be scanned at Wet'n'Wild on the day). Should the pass be invalid, not able to be scanned or not presented on the day, the child will be charged the applicable entry rate. Parents who have their child's pass in their phone can check the validity of this through the app prior to sending a screen shot to the school office.

Transport to and from Wet'n'Wild will be by private vehicle. We have many students who are under 10 years so we will need lots of parent support on the day. All parents are welcome to come along. I will be able to cover the entry fee cost for up to 8 drivers.

If you are available to transport and help supervise students at Wet'n'Wild on Tuesday 17 December, please indicate on the form below how many passengers you can carry in your vehicle. Please provide copies of the following to the office by Friday, 6.12.2024:

- your WWCC number (available from Services NSW at no cost)
- your Driver's Licence
- your car registration and insurance details

### **EXCURSION DETAILS:**

**Cost for students:** \$20.00 per student or a current Annual pass

**Arrive at MPS:** 8:40am NSW

**Depart MPS:** 9:00am NSW

**Return MPS:** Approx 6:00pm NSW

**Wear:** Appropriate sun-safe swimmers, including a rash shirt to cover the shoulders and arms. Board shorts are advised for additional sun safety. Broad brimmed hat. Joggers and socks. Bring thongs for poolside.

**Sunscreen:** Students must be completely covered in sunscreen and have their own sunscreen to re-apply at regular intervals throughout the day.

**Bring:** School bag containing own recess, lunch and afternoon tea. Please ensure you provide enough food to last your child throughout the day. Please do not plan for students to buy lunch on the day as it is too difficult to supervise.

Own towel and change of dry clothes for the return trip to school. A plastic bag to hold wet clothing is also a good idea.

Own water bottle. **No glass** is allowed in the Park

**Money:** Students are able to bring a small amount of money to buy drinks/iceblock etc. Each child is responsible for their own possessions, including money.

**Valuable items should not be brought on the day.** Our gear will be left unsupervised in our allocated shade shelter throughout the day.

Students are to remain together in groups throughout the day and must follow rules as set down by MPS staff and Wet'n'Wild. This will include signing on at our shade shelter at regular intervals to note that sunscreen has been reapplied. In accordance with Wet'n'Wild policy, students who are 10 years and under will be in a group with an adult at all times. Students who are not proficient swimmers (yellow wrist band) will be in a group with adults at all times.

***RELATING TO EXCURSIONS TO QUEENSLAND:***

As there is currently no reciprocal arrangements for ambulance services between New South Wales and Queensland, parents are advised that in the unlikely event of an accident whilst in Queensland, you will be financially liable for the cost of any ambulance transport.

Parents are advised to check their medical cover to ensure that ambulance transport is covered and in the event they do not have private medical insurance consider accessing appropriate ambulance transport cover. The school takes out annual NSW ambulance membership and this covers the transport of all students anywhere in New South Wales should the need arise.

When completing the permission note attached, please ensure that you fill in the section regarding ambulance cover. Please contact the school if you have any queries.

Please make sure the attached permission note is returned by Friday 6 December 2024 to enable final numbers to be confirmed and transport arrangements to be finalised.
