

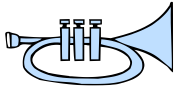


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INSTRUMENTAL BAND PROGRAM 2022

Information and Instrument Tryout Session



Dear Parents,

I am pleased to announce a new intake for our instrumental/band program, which will be offered to students currently in Years 2, 3 and 4. Children need to be mature and confident in schoolwork, especially reading before commencing an instrument. I am happy to consult with the parent and class teacher to discuss this. **Please note: this will be the only opportunity for your child to join the band program this year. The next planned opportunity will be in Term 3 of 2023.**

Depending on demand, tuition may be offered for the following instruments:

We are offering the children the opportunity to learn an instrument. As it is important that we have a variety of instruments in the band, after trying all of the instruments to see which ones suit their body best, students in consultation with their parents will be asked to choose three instruments they would like to play. Allocation of instrument will then be made by Mrs Armour and advised to parents to ensure the needs of the child and the band are best met.

For those people who do not own an instrument, we will be offering information on rental/purchase plans. Most flute players will need a curved head flute which is for smaller students. Please don't purchase an instrument before having your child checked for instrument suitability and after your child's instrument to play has been allocated. The school has a limited number of instruments available for hire.

Lessons will be in student compatible groups with the emphasis being on ensemble work, co-operation within the ensemble and band. Individual lessons may also be available. Group lessons are currently \$19 per week. Individual lessons are currently \$30 per week. **Note:** Drums are only offered as an individual lesson

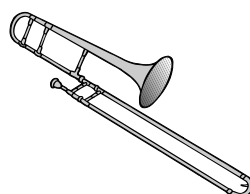
All children in the instrumental program are required to play with our band, attend weekly rehearsals and commit to lessons and band.

Due to COVID restrictions, we are unable to hold a parent/child information and instrument tryout session as we have in previous years. This year, Mr Pines (one of our Music Tutors) will be assessing each student for instrument suitability during the school day next Friday 1 April. After your child attends the assessment for instrument suitability with Mr Pines, we will send home a parent information pack and enrolment form with each student. This parent information pack will contain full details of our instrument program and will also advise which instruments your child is suitable to play.

Please advise me if your child has any disability that may need consideration when selecting an instrument. I anticipate lessons commencing early Term 2.
